

### **Meeting Minutes**

Meeting notes for November 7th, 2024.

David Flett called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited and observed. Sprague Fleming let us in prayer. Twenty-three members were in attendance. Several new members attended the meeting. New members Jeremy and Henry Nicholson came to the meeting. Jeremy and Henry have a very sharp 1967 coupe that we've seen before at Cars and Coffee.

The first order of business was the treasurer's report. As of November 7th, there was \$6,236.02 in the kitty.

The club has agreed to honor Vernon "Mick" Carr with a brick at the Lubbock War Memorial near Leroy Elmore Park. The process has begun at the approved cost of \$125. As of now we're looking at a dedication date in June of 2025. A donation of \$200 to Salvation Army has been agreed upon to honor Sarah Renfrow Quattlebaum. Keep member Ron Boyer in your prayers as he has experienced some recent health issues.

Two members of "Wreaths Across America", Tammy Pridis and her husband, attended our meeting. Wreaths Across America began in 1992 when the Worcester Wreath Company of Harrington, Maine donated some unsold wreaths to Arlington Cemetery in Washington DC. Since then Wreaths Across America has become a full-fledged national charity, setting wreaths at the burial sites of veterans across the country. Ten wreaths are available for \$17 apiece. The club has agreed to purchase 10 wreaths for a total of \$170. The club has also agreed to help Wreaths Across America set wreaths throughout the Slaton Memorial Cemetery on December 14<sup>th</sup>. We'll need about 10 cars at the cemetery for the event. Mark your calendars to meet at the Slaton Memorial Cemetery at 11:00 a.m. on December 14<sup>th</sup>.

Dennis Quattlebaum gave the Mustang Club of America (MCA) Report. Jim Kaden of MCA has led a donation drive through Samaritan's Purse to help with the hurricane relief efforts in North Carolina and Florida. The club has agreed to donate \$200 to Samaritan's Purse to help in those hurricane relief efforts. Our next job is to send an email to Jim Kaden about our donation.

About 10 cars showed up for our Christmas is For Kids toy drive at Comet Cleaners on south Slide Road. I showed up late but Tommy was still there and I was happy to see an overflowing box of toys inside.
