




Here are the details on my straight six I would like to have listed to our fellow club members.

The engine is a 68 block that puts out black smoke when cold but smooths out after it heats up. It has a new improved exhaust manifold and a new single barrel carb. There is one manifold bolt that has stripped but there is no evidence of leaking. The intake manifold is original but it does cause vapor lock in the summertime thanks to its location. Over the last 5 years of driving it, it has not given me any problems or concerns. The oil pan may need to be replaced as the previous owner beet it up. It still holds oil but appearance wise it is not nice. Do note the alternator, AC pump, oil cap and air cleaner will not be included.

I am asking \$300 for it, but I am open to reasonable offers. Delivery not available.
